Dear Applicant:

The Military Order of the Stars and Bars has established a college scholarship program for genealogically proven: (1) descendants of Confederate Officers; (2) descendants of the Confederate Executive or Legislative branches of government; and (3) descendants of members of the Confederate States' legislatures, judiciary, and executive branches of government.

The MOS&B Scholarship Program annually recognizes and awards merit based scholarships to worthy individuals who meet eligibility requirements and have been judged on information submitted by the applicant.

The General Executive Council has determined that each Department scholarship awarded will be in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000). The number of scholarships awarded to each Department will be two. Additional scholarships may be awarded as determined by the General Executive Council and subject to available funds.

Scholarship candidates should carefully read the "**Scholarship Application Information Sheet**" and the "**General Information and Data Required From Applicants**" sheet and then complete all requirements. The requested material should be packaged together and mailed to the **MOS&B Scholarship Committee c/o Past Commander General Daniel W. Jones, 525 Ellynn Drive, Cary, NC 27511**. The requested information should be **postmarked no later than March 1<sup>st</sup> to be eligible**.
